

Cut line for lining

Fold Line

Pocket Template:
4.5 W x 5.5 long finished
Use 1/2 Seam Allowances on side and bottom

It is often EASIER to make a lined pocket.
To do so, cut out one of fashion fabric
One of lining (or contrast lighter fashion fabric)
Stitch the lining to the pocket right sides together
on 3 sides (side, bottom, side.)

Fold the top of the pocket down and line up raw edges of lining top.
Leave a 1" opening for turning, stitch. The lining is shorter than the pocket
Turn the pocket right side out and press. The pocket will have a folded over
top of fashion fabric, and is still sewn to the lining. Press the seam allowances
UP to the top of the pocket (inside) and stitch
across the pocket at the top of the lining join to secure the opening
and create a topstitched pocket

Position the pocket on the garment, pin in place and stitch three sides
side, bottom, side, securing with backstitching at the top of the pocket.
